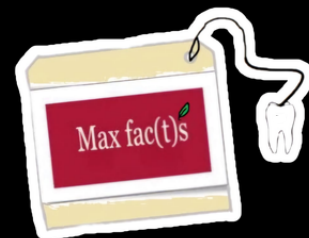

EXTRASINUS VERSUS INTRASINUS APPROACH FOR ZYGOMATIC IMPLANT PLACEMENT

- Jain DK et al. conducted a prospective study to compare two different types of surgical approaches (Intrasinus vs Extrasinus) for the placement of zygomatic implants to treat atrophic maxilla.
- It was observed that postoperative pain and swelling was significantly higher in intra sinus approach as compared to extra sinus approach.
- The intranasal approach also had poor patient compliance or low satisfaction rate as compared to extra sinus approach.
- On the basis of the results of the study, it was concluded that extra sinus approach has got an edge over intra sinus approach.

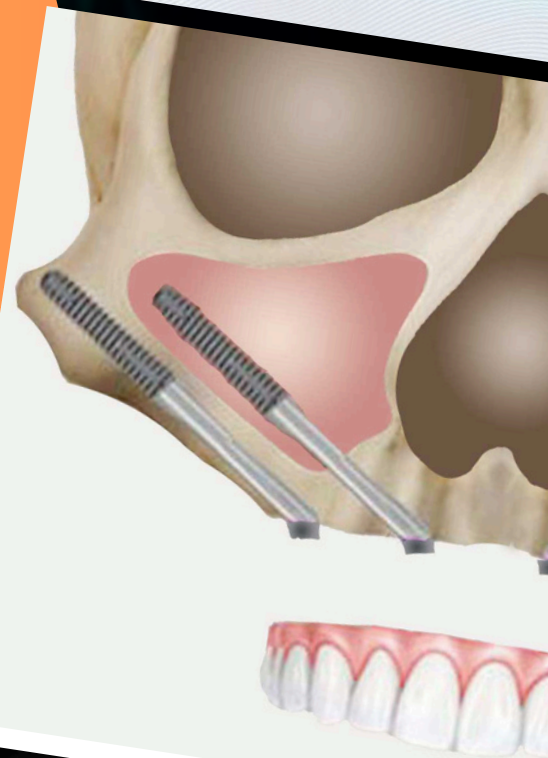


Babies in the womb develop lizard-like hand muscles, remnants of 250-million-year-old evolution, which most lose before birth.
